Watering Your New Plants

Year One

After planting, water plants as soon as you can get them in the ground. **DCL has done the first initial watering.** Allow the water to soak in and drain, and then water again until the soil is thoroughly moistened.

For the First 2 Weeks After Planting...

Water newly planted plants frequently - daily - The roots will be unable to access soil moisture from a very large area until they begin to grow.

After Two Weeks or So...

Unless the weather is extremely hot and dry, you may be able to decrease watering frequency, perhaps to two or three times per week for the next month or so.

Time of Day to Water: Water in the early morning, or late afternoon. Do not water in the middle of the day it is too hot - or early evening - plants need to dry off before nightfall to avoid mildew and other complications.

New plants do not yet have sufficient root systems to sustain themselves. The idea is to water regularly so that the roots will grow deeply into the soil and eventually provide enough root structure to be self-sustaining in all but extreme drought.
