Watering Your New Seed

Try not to mow for 7-10 days after seeding.

You must water every day, set automatic timers for about 5-10 minutes early in the morning and again at mid-day for the first **10 days**, then reduce to once per day and adjust the amount of water according to temperature demands. At this point the seed and the soil must stay moist. Watering done by hand or hos-end sprinklers must be constantly and evenly applied. It should provide approximately the same amount of moisture throughout, but less in shady areas.

If the seed or sprout **dries out, it dies out**. Your mission then, is always to provide adequate moisture. The pre-sprout phase is most critical. Your commitment to watering new grass seed must stay strong. The germination time for **fine bladed fescue** is 10-14 days. It can be longer than this in cooler temperatures.

Once the new grass is visible, the roots are also growing down into the soil. As soil moisture below ground is more accessible to the roots, the plant is not so vulnerable now. **Seeds will not sprout** all at the same time. Seeds will be buried at different depths, absorb water differently, or be of different quality or maturity.

Over-watering that will result in puddles on the surface can allow the seed to float around and be washed away.
